Who Should Apply

Eligibility

- Minimum 3 years of professional experience
- Engineering degree or relevant Master's degree
- Age limit: Up to 45 years (SIDS & LDCs)
Up to 40 years (other countries)

Nomination Process



- Each ISA Member, Signatory, and Prospective Member Country may nominate two candidates, ensuring one male and one female nominee, to promote balanced representation.
- Nominations must be submitted through the ISA National Focal Point, or the designated nodal ministry, and candidates must also complete the online application through the IIT Delhi portal.
